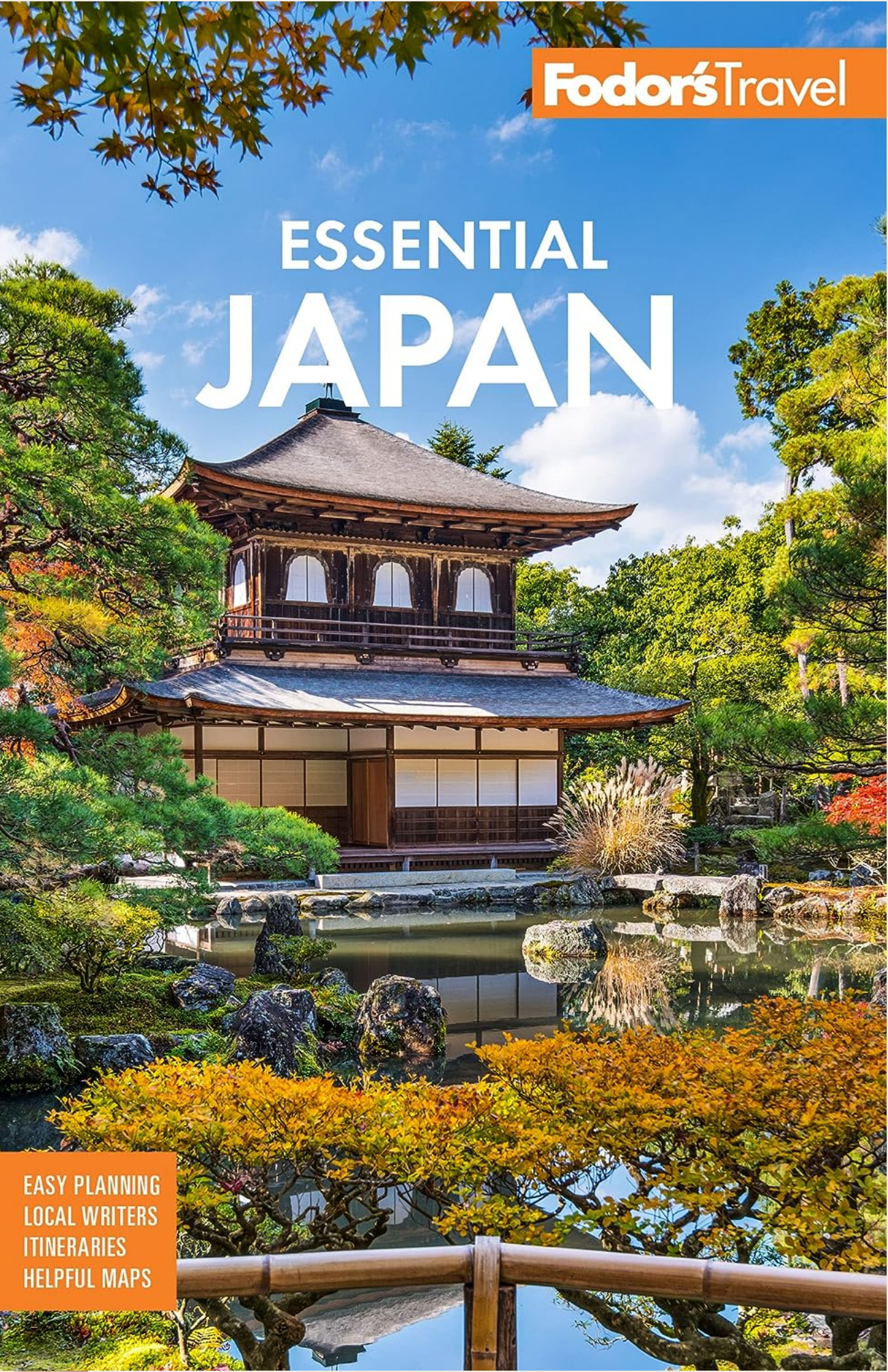
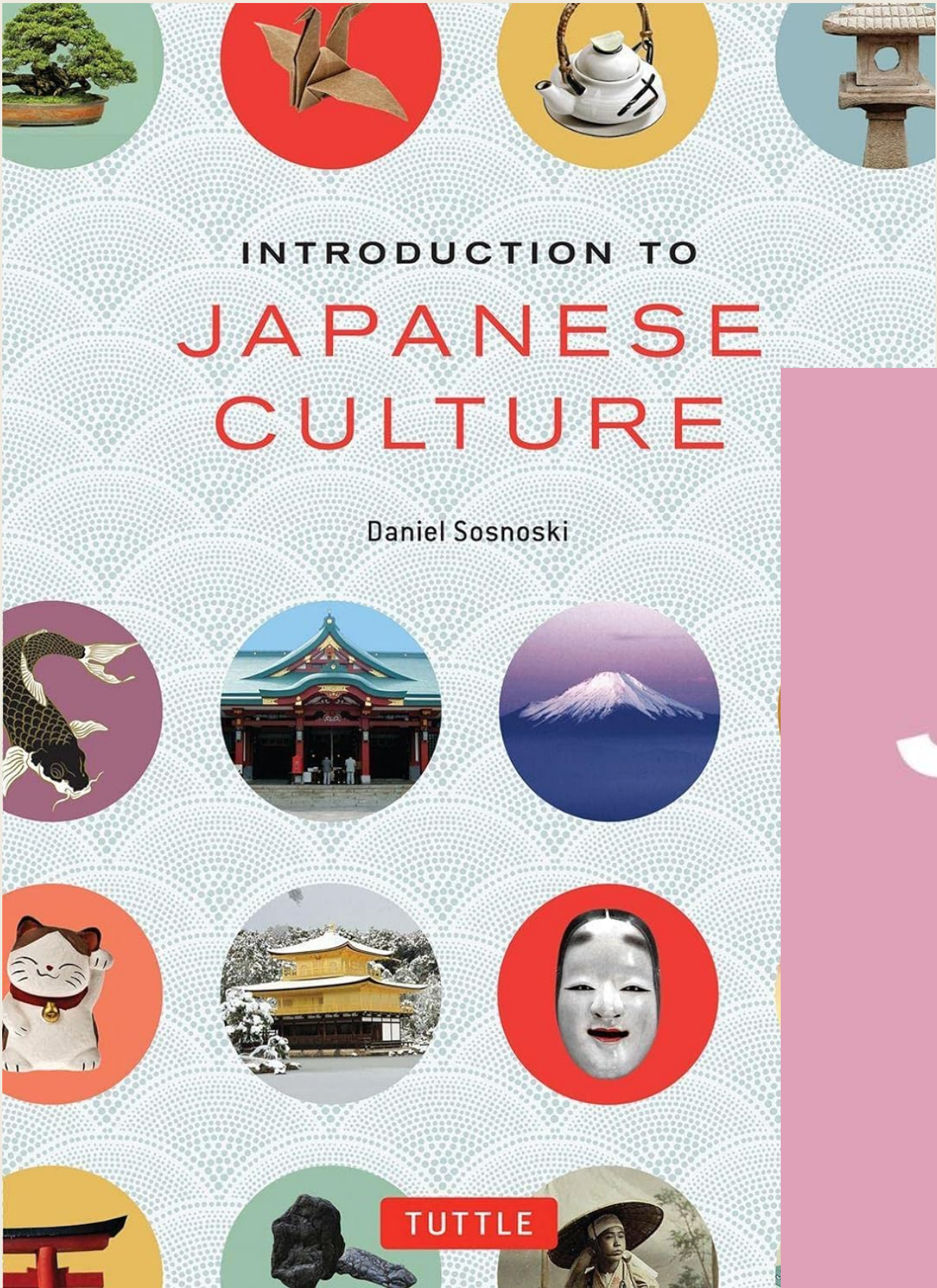
Summary

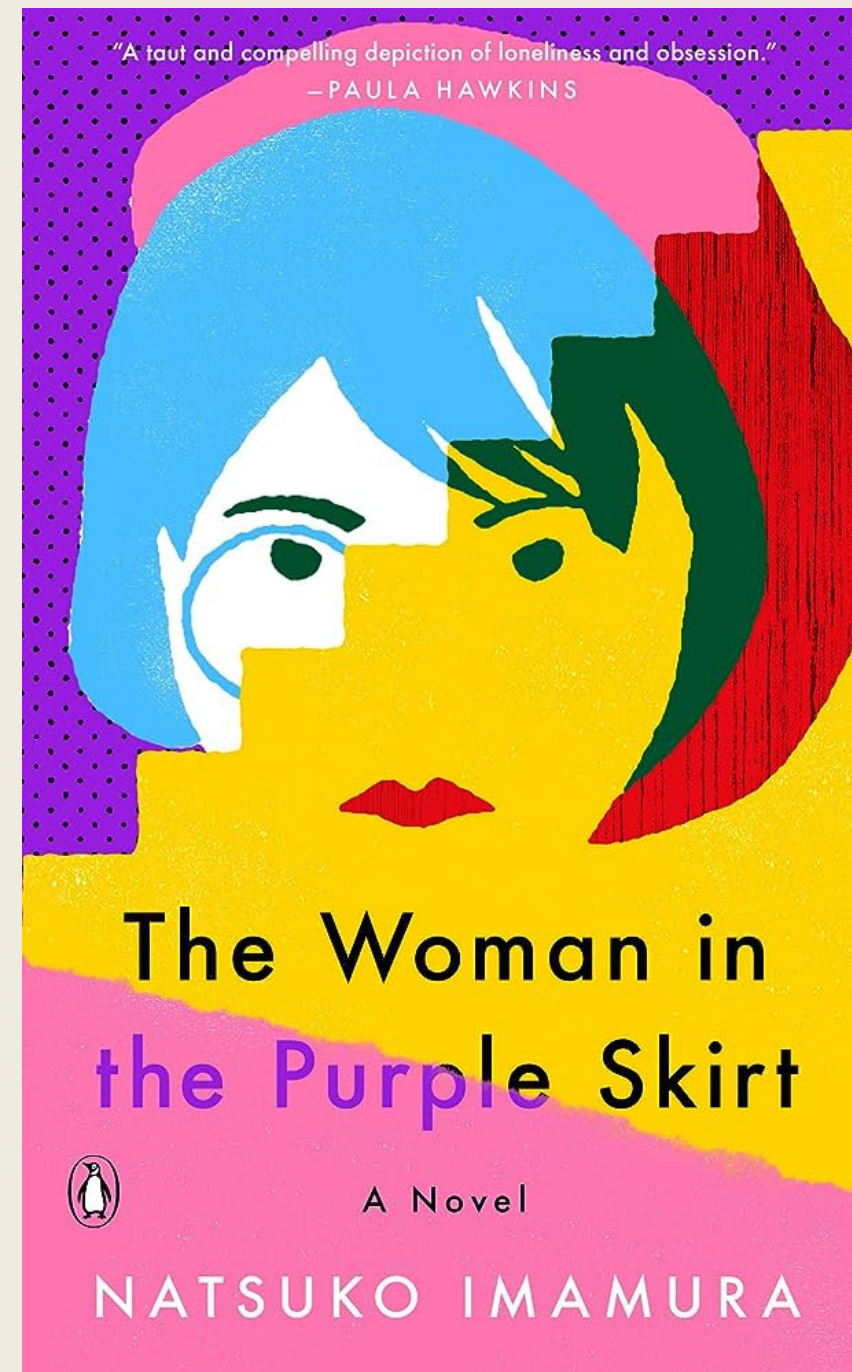

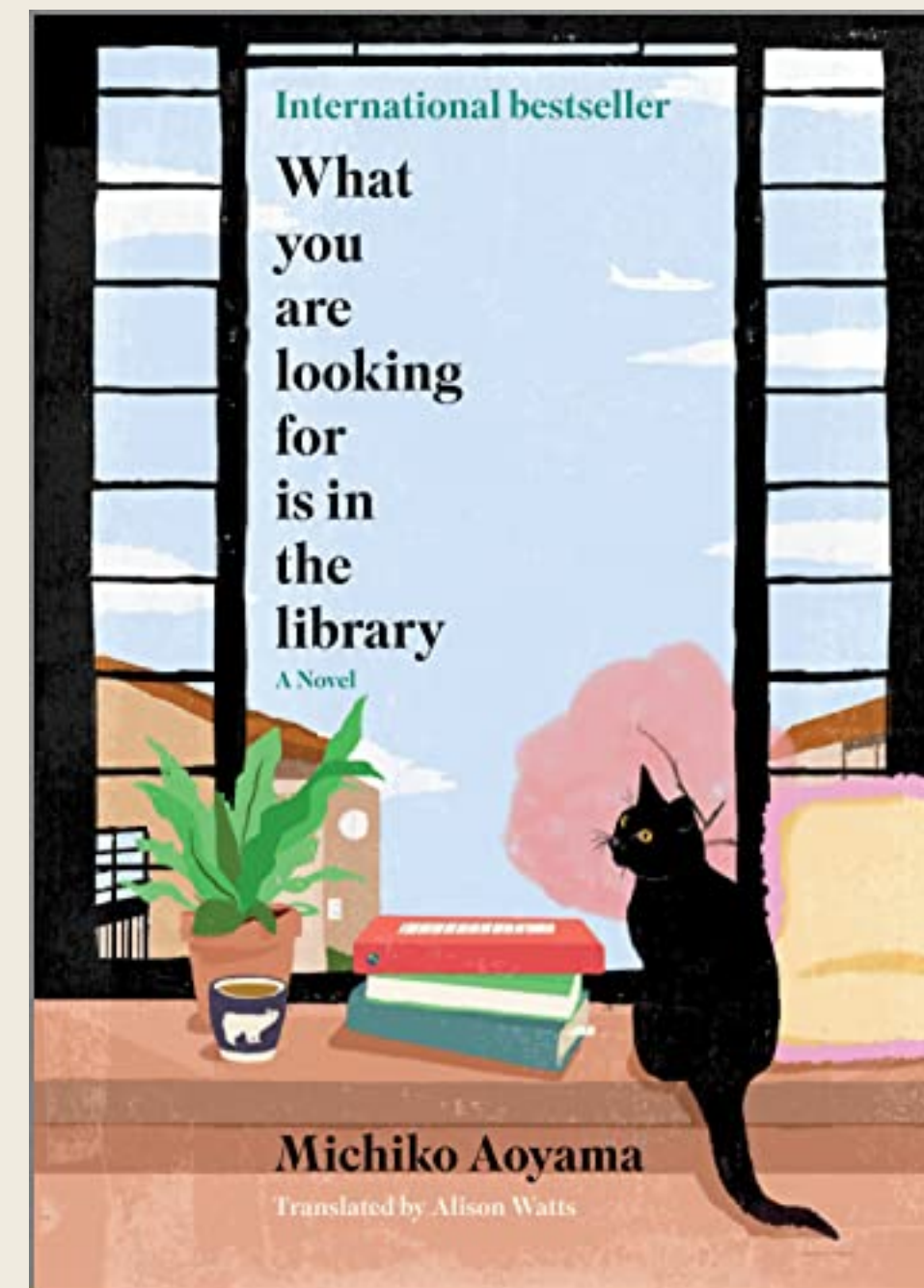

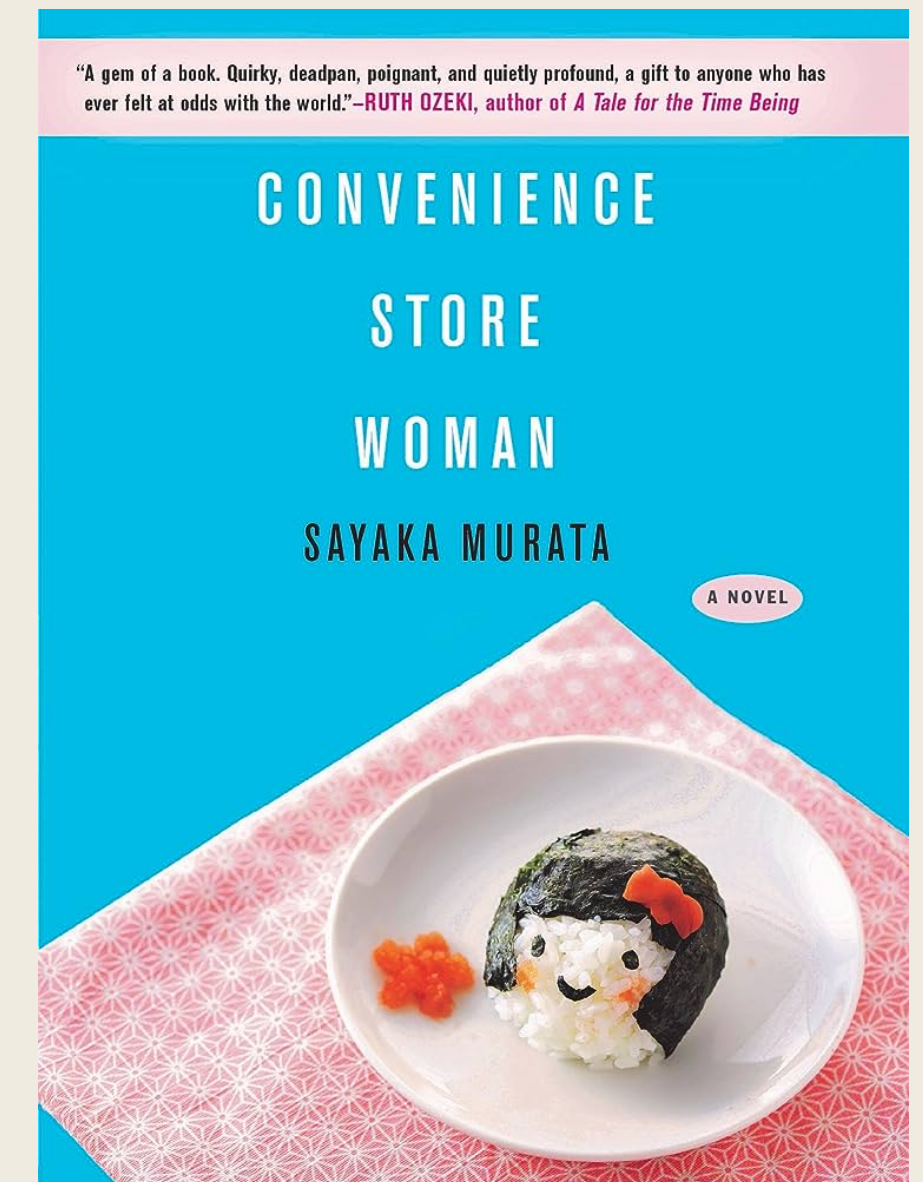
All Japanese translated books about woman in the workplace.
